KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Performing health assessments and various clinical tasks such as IM & S/C injections, wound care, removing stitches/staples, ear irrigation, cryotherapy, Ankle-Brachial Index (ABIs) and ECGs
- Vaccinating patients of all ages as per the Publicly Funded Immunization Schedules for Ontario
- Performing well baby developmental evaluations of children 0 to 6 years old and providing parent education
- Providing patient teaching and counseling on various topics such as smoking cessation, diabetes, contraception and cardiovascular disease
- Managing test results received from the labs/imaging and prescription renewals received from pharmacies
- Providing telephone advice to patients, including providing test results
- Assisting the physician during procedures
- Participating in meetings to improve the quality of care delivered in the clinic

REQUIREMENTS:

- Current registration as Registered Practical Nurse with the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO)
- Certificate of Professional Liability Protection with the Registered Practical Nurses Association of Ontario (RPNAO), the Canadian Nurses Protective Society (CNPS) or equivalent



- Strong knowledge of the health problems that can arise in a family medicine practice for all clients from birth to old age
- Demonstrated ability to work with other health professionals in an interdisciplinary team
- Excellent clinical judgment and a strong sense of initiative
- Excellent knowledge of primary and secondary prevention of the most common chronic diseases
- Able to teach an individual or a group about various themes related to chronic diseases such as cardiovascular disease, pulmonary disease, smoking cessation and diabetes
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Demonstrated aptitude in working with computer systems
- Valid CPR certification
- Able to communicate fluently, verbally and in writing, in both French and English
- Proof of up-to-date vaccinations and/or proof of immunity. Required vaccinations include MMR (measles, mumps and rubella), tetanus, hepatitis B and COVID-19 (three doses)
